

The November program will feature Joshua Lindamood. Mr. Lindamood’s presentation is titled, *“Let The Thing Be Pressed: The Battle of Sailor’s Creek.”*



Joshua Lindamood is a Certified Interpretive Guide through the National Association of Interpretation. He currently works as a park ranger at Sailor’s Creek Battlefield Historical State Park. There he spends his time helping with day-to-day operations, leading historical tours of the battlefield and the Hillsman House, and is currently researching The Savannah Volunteer Guard and specifically their involvement on April 6th. When not at Sailor’s Creek, Joshua also works at Appomattox Court House National Historical Park as a first-person living history interpreter. There you may find him lighting his pipe or playing the harmonica on the Clover Hill Tavern porch as he portrays a former Confederate soldier.

Greetings and welcome to the 2020-2021 campaign of the Lynchburg Civil War Round Table! To say that we ended the 2019-2020 campaign on a bit of a sour note would be an understatement as Covid-19 wiped out our April and May meetings. Please take a moment to browse through this upcoming season's schedule of speakers and topics included in this newsletter. I hope you agree that we have some wonderful and entertaining Wednesday evenings to look forward to!

I am pleased to announce that all member fees will remain the same in regards to yearly dues (\$35 family; \$25 individual; \$10 student) and dinner (\$20). The fee for guests will remain at \$25 to attend dinner and the program. The guest fee to attend the program only, and not dine, will remain at \$5. Please make arrangements to pay your 2020-2021 dues as soon as possible, as this is the primary means used to financially compensate our speakers, assist with their travel expenses, and to pay for their lodging. Meetings will continue to follow the same time schedule as in the past and will commence with a social hour from 6-7 PM, followed by a buffet dinner at 7 PM. I have been advised that the wait staff will be following all necessary safety protocols as suggested by the VDH as "*best practices*" and will include them wearing face coverings and serving you as you proceed through the buffet line. Certain items, such as salads, dressing, and desserts will be prepared ahead of time and served in a covered container. You are asked to kindly wear a mask when proceeding through the buffet line and maintain social distance while in line waiting to be served. There will be hand sanitizer readily available and it is suggested that you make use of it and avoid all unnecessary touching, including shaking hands. After eating, it is at your discretion as to whether or not to put your mask back on during the speaker's program. I have requested that they put us in the large banquet room as much as possible this season to assist with social distancing. We will have use of that room in September and hopefully October too at this point. Please use discretion when choosing a table to sit at in order to maintain proper social distancing. **DO NOT ATTEND IF YOU ARE NOT FEELING WELL, RUNNING A FEVER, HAVE COLD/FLU LIKE SYMPTONS!** We need to do everything physically possible to keep one another safe and healthy! LCWRT business will be conducted at

approximately 7:45 PM in order to allow our guest speaker to have the floor by 8 PM, if not sooner. We will continue to have a raffle as part of the meeting. The proceeds from the raffle allow the LCWRT to make monetary contributions to the Civil War Trust for battlefield preservation or to some other worthy cause. 
I was particularly pleased with the number of guests and new members we had joining us last season! A job well-done by all of you! Keep spreading the word so we can continue to see future growth!
